ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

Our Academic Programme is designed to be....

- Holistic, thus helping our student-athletes to strike a balance between academic and sporting development.

SCHOLASTIC YEAR

The scholastic year runs on a 5-day week, 3-term schedule, starting in late September and ending in June. There will be a Christmas & Easter recess, and mid-term holidays.

STIPENDS

Our Sport Programme offers....

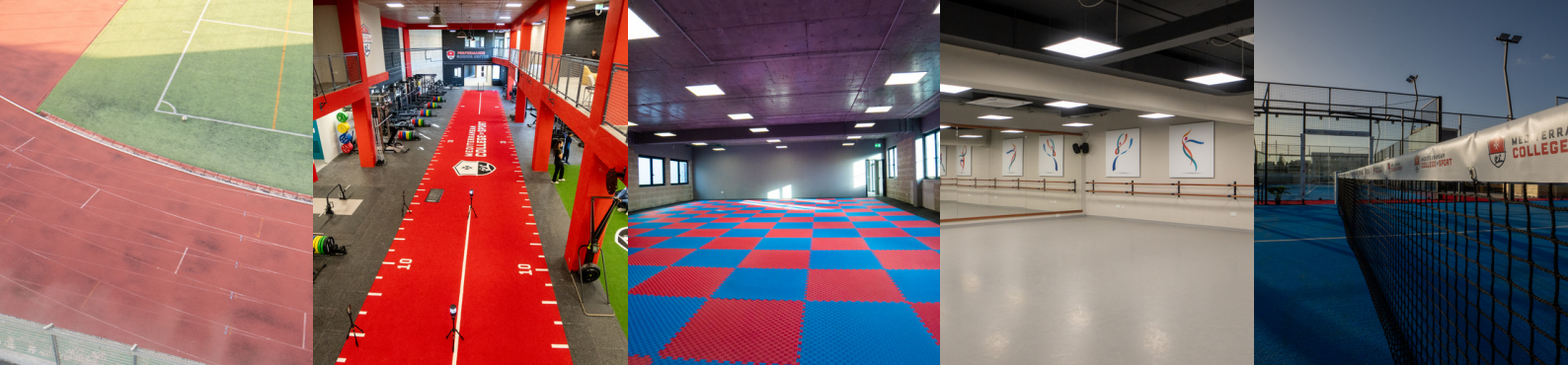
- A dynamic and comprehensive programme designed specifically for student-athletes at sixth form.

- A high challenge with high support, pushing our athletes out of their comfort zones, allowing them to grow, learn from setbacks, and develop their skills and character.

SPORT DISCIPLINES

ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES

Above all we strongly believe in an all-round education and that our Sixth Form should broaden horizons. ACADEMIC AND SPORT FACILITIES

The Mediterranean College of Sport Sixth Form offers a state-of-the-art campus with spacious lecture rooms, well-equipped science laboratories with internet access and projection facilities, a library, a study room and common room.

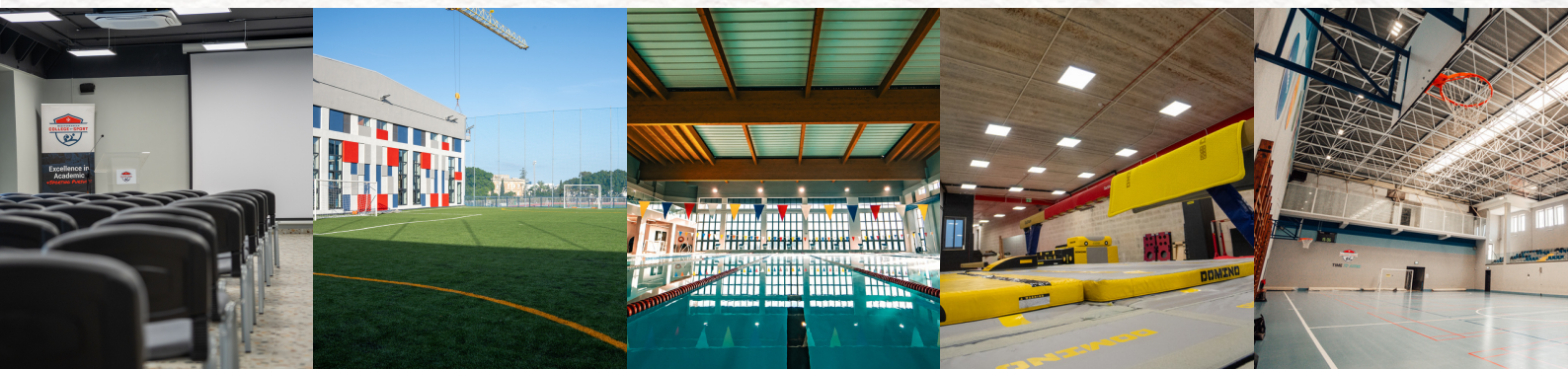
As a college of sport, our facilities reflect our commitment to sport excellence and holistic development. Our international-standard Athletics Track allows student-athletes to push their limits, whether they are sprinters, long-distance runners, or high jumpers.

For footballers, we offer two exceptional pitches—a full-size pitch for matches, training, and tournaments, and a seven-a-side pitch for smaller games and friendly matches.

Swimming enthusiasts will find a top-tier 25-metre, eight-lane Swimming Pool with a retractable roof, designed to meet competitive standards while also offering space for leisure and training.

A standout feature of our college is the Multi-Sport Pavilion, a versatile space for various indoor sports. For those inclined toward movement and dance, we provide two fully equipped Dance Studios.

Our commitment to comprehensive athletic development extends to gymnastics, with a state-of-the-art Gymnastics Hall that ensures a safe and supportive training environment. Additionally, we offer a fully equipped Fitness Centre for overall well-being and two Padel courts within our sports complex. The X-factor at MCS is the Performance Science Centre. This is a state-of-the-art facility, one of the largest in the Mediterranean, designed to meet the diverse needs of athletes.



OUR COURSES

The Mediterranean College of Sport Sixth Form will offer a choice of two curricular programmes:

- The Matriculation Certificate course for entry into the University of Malta.

or

- Entry into International Universities

MATRICULATION CERTIFICATE

Course Content

- Two subjects at Advanced Level
- Three subjects at Intermediate level
- Systems of Knowledge (SOK)

Subject Choice

- Subjects are divided into groups.
- Student athletes are to choose one subject from each of Group 1, Group 2 and Group 3, and two additional subjects from any group.
- Systems of Knowledge (SOK) is compulsory for students taking this course.
- No subject may be taken at both advanced and intermediate level.
- Choice of subjects may be dependent on timetable constraints.

Subject Groups (****Offered at A Level only** and ***Offered at Intermediate Level only**)

- Group 1: English and Maltese
- Group 2: Accounting, Economics, Marketing, Philosophy**, and Psychology*
- Group 3: Biology, Chemistry**, Computing, Environmental Science, Physics, Pure Mathematics
- Group 4: Physical Education*
- Group 5: Systems of Knowledge (SOK)

INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITIES

To enter the 3 Advanced Level course students must choose three (3) areas of learning at an Advanced Level.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Students must have a minimum of five passes at MQF Level 3 (or equivalent). English Language, Maltese, and Mathematics are entry requirements for entry to the University of Malta.
- Passes must be in the Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) at MQF Level 3 issued by MATSEC or IGCSE or an equivalent at EQF Level 3.



Students residing in Malta may apply for the **Achieve 360 Scholarship Scheme-Excellence in Sport and Education** if they satisfy the Eligibility and Selection Criteria of the Scheme.
